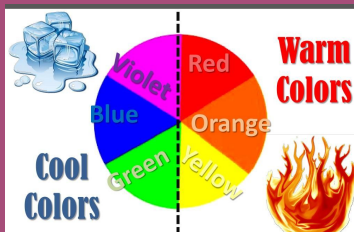
Subject: Unified Arts (Art, Music, P.E., STEAM)
